Search of Student Lockers, Desks, Personal Possessions and Student's Person

I have read and understand all the aspects of Policy # 502.

I understand that:

- school lockers are the property of the school district,
- inspection of the interior of lockers may be conducted by the school for any reason at any time, without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant,
- inspection of the interior of school desks may be conducted by school officials for any reason at any time, without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant,
- the personal possessions of students and/or a student's person may be searched when school officials have reasonable suspicion that the search will uncover a violation of school law or school rules
- personal possessions include but is not limited to purses, backpacks, book bags, packages and clothing.
